Who is eligible? ---- Any Landstown High School student in grade 9, 10, 11, or 12 who would like to enhance their leadership ability and who is interested in a weekend of fun should apply. Approximately 100 students will be selected.

What happens during a leadership workshop? ---- Our workshop is one night and two days of spirit and enthusiasm with hands-on activities and practical leadership experiences. You will meet new people and form close ties with other Landstown students. When you return from workshop, you will be prepared to lead effectively at Landstown High School and in the community.

When and **where** is the workshop? ---- The workshop will be held at 4H Camp in James City County, Virginia, from **Friday, March 22 to Saturday, March 23**. On Friday morning, we will gather in the schola for the opening assembly. We will return on Saturday in the afternoon. Transportation to and from 4H will be provided by VBCPS school buses. Delegates will be responsible for providing transportation to and from Landstown High School.

What is the cost? ---- In order to cover part of the cost for room/board, supplies, meals, a t-shirt, and a handbook, you will be asked to pay a fee, depending on when you submit your application:

Early Bird Fee: \$30 (Application and money submitted by December 21st)

Regular Fee: \$35 (Application and money submitted by January 31st)

Last Minute Fee: \$40 (Application due February 28th, Money from accepted delegates due March 6th. Submitting an application indicates that you commit to attending and paying your fee)

Fees can be paid with cash or check made payable to LHS.

How can I apply? ---- If you would like to attend, please complete the application and return the signature page to Room 408. **Applications that are complete and PAID prior to the December 21st and January 31st deadlines guarantee acceptance** except for disciplinary issues which will be evaluated at the discretion of the Administration and workshop coordinators. *Applications submitted between Feb. 1st-28th will be evaluated by coordinators and accepted students will be contacted March 1st.*
