### Homework

Homework assignments are to be completed and present in class on the due date. Late homework will be accepted for half credit one block late. Some homework will be collected and assessed for correctness while other for completion. Total homework grade will not exceed 10% of overall marking period grade.

### Late Work

Late homework assignments may be completed by the next class meeting for half credit. Lab projects, programs, or labs must be completed by one class meeting after the unit assessment. Penalty of no more than 50% will be assessed and only if lack of effort or failure to seek guidance is the rationale for a late assignment.

### Explanation of Zeroes

Every effort will be made to hold students accountable for completing missed assessments before assigning a zero. However, a zero will be assigned for any assignment not submitted. Additionally, the late work policy will be applied if assignment is past due.

### Reassessment

No reassessment will be administered.

### Make-up Work

Students will have 3 school days to makeup work missed for an excused absence. It will be the student's responsibility to ask the instructor for the makeup work. Any assignment assigned prior to the absence will be due upon return to school. Unique situations will be addressed on an individual basis and must be communicated to the instructor immediately upon return to school. Students with an unexcused absence may makeup assignments for credit at the instructor's discretion.

### Extra Credit

Extra credit will only be assigned and accepted when all other required assignments are complete. Any and all extra credit will be related to course objectives. Extra credit will not be used to inflate or bump a grade up.
