Homework

Homework assignments are to be completed and presented in class on the due date. Late homework will be accepted for half credit one block late. Some homework will be collected and assessed for correctness while others for completion. Total homework grade will not exceed 10% of overall marking period grade.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted one block late and will receive half credit.

Explanation of Zeroes

Work not submitted or completed will be entered as a zero before the end of a quarter. All work not submitted due to absences will be handled by the late work and make up work policies.

Reassessment

No reassessment will be administered.

Make-up Work

Students will have 3 school days to makeup work missed for an excused absence. It will be the student's responsibility to ask the instructor for the makeup work. Any assignment assigned prior to the absence will be due upon return to school. Unique situations will be addressed on an individual basis and must be communicated to the instructor immediately upon return to school. Students with an unexcused absence may makeup assignments for credit at the instructor's discretion.

Extra Credit

Extra credit shall be used sparingly and purposefully as an opportunity for further learning. Teachers will clearly articulate to students how an extra credit assignment is aligned to curricular objectives. Extra credit shall be related to the current topic of study, fairly available and accessible, and require the use of only those resources known to be available to all students. Extra credit will not be used for non-learning activities.
