Homework

Homework will not normally be assigned and will not be graded if assigned. The purpose of any homework assignment will be to reinforce the concepts discussed in class and may be reviewed in class but will not affect a student's grade. Students should use these assignments to assess their own understanding. Tests, quizzes and classwork, when assigned, will be used to assess a student progress by the teacher.

Late Work

Any classwork assignments that are to be graded can be turned in any time up to one week prior to the end of a marking period with no penalty. These assignments are designed to reinforce the concepts covered in class and are opportunities for students to practice, learn, and be evaluated on their progress. Any projects assigned that are turned in after the due date, unless special circumstances dictate otherwise, will be assessed a 10% penalty and may be turned in with the same caveats as classwork assignments.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeroes will be given to assignments not completed on time. Unique situations will be addressed on an individual basis and must be communicated to the instructor.

Reassessment

No reassessment will be administered.

Make-up Work

Students will have 3 school days to make up work missed due to an excused absence. It will be the student's responsibility to ask the instructor for make-up work. Any assignment assigned prior to the absence will be due upon return to school. Unique situations will be addressed on an individual basis and must be communicated to the instructor upon returning to school. Student with an unexcused absence may make up assignments for credit at the instructor's discretion.

Extra Credit

If extra credit is available, it will be built into the assessment and it will be related to current objectives.
