Homework

Homework is only assigned when classwork is not completed during the class time, with the exception of studying and the completion of the Tutorial Request Form. If the Tutorial Request Form is not completed at home, students will be given 5 minutes to complete the TRF at the beginning of the class period and will be assessed after the 5 minutes.

Late Work

Students will be able to turn in late work for complete credit provided the student:

- communicates with the teacher the reason(s) for an extension;
- agrees upon the time frame the assignment will be completed.

Explanation of Zeroes

Students who miss or do not complete assessments shall be assessed a grade that is 50% of the assessment total until the assessment is completed or reassessed. When the assessment has been completed it will be assessed for full credit.

Reassessment

Any student receiving a failing grade on a binder check, portfolio assignment, quiz, or paper/project may be given an opportunity for reassessment provided the student has sought addition instruction and demonstrated evidence of best effort on the assessment.

Make-up Work

Students will be allowed to make up all assessments due to excused or unexcused absences. All make-up work will be assessed for full credit. Make-up work must be completed in a reasonable timeframe agreed upon by the student and teacher. If the make-up work is not completed within the agreed upon timeframe the student will receive 50% of the assessment total.

Extra Credit

Extra credit can be awarded for the following assessments: Binder Checks and Tutorials. Extra credit will be awarded for binder checks based on the proficiency of the note taking and organizational skills. Extra credit for

tutorials will be based upon the quality of the level of inquiry and collaboration. Extra credit will not be used for non-learning activities.
