



Grading Practices

School: Landstown High School, Governor's STEM and Technology Academy

Subject(s): Academy

Grade Level: 9-12

Homework

All project work will be completed during the regularly scheduled class period. Exceptions for students with extended time via their approved IEP/504 plan will be accommodated by the teacher. Each teacher will determine if curriculum related homework assignments are needed. All homework assignments will be assigned a "due date" when the teacher assign them to the students. These assignments may or may not be a "graded" assignment. (As designated by the teacher when assigned.)

Late Work

Students will have five days to complete assignments (after the assigned due date). Any assignment turned in after the five day period will be eligible to earn a maximum grade of 80%. All students are expected to complete ALL assignments by the end of the grading period. Any assignments not completed by the end of the grading period will be assigned a grade of 50%.

Explanation of Zeroes

Students will have 5 days to complete assignments (After the assigned due date). Any assignment turned in after the 5 day period will be eligible to earn a maximum grade of 80%. All students are expected to complete ALL assignments by the end of the grading period. Any assignments not completed by the end of the grading period will be assigned a grade of 50%. Students who exhibit a chronic pattern of behavior around missing work need further evaluation and increased levels of support, such as: parental notification, classroom interventions, referral for guidance support services, SRT Meeting.

Extra Credit

Extra credit shall be used sparingly and purposefully as an opportunity for further learning. Teachers will clearly articulate to students how an extra credit assignment is aligned to curricular objectives. Extra credit shall be

related to the current topic of study, fairly available and accessible, and require the use of only those resources known to be available to all students. Extra credit will not be used for non-learning activities, such as (but not limited to): field trip forms, Open House flyers, Fundraising materials.
